

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING – May 14, 2019

Carolyn Zorn reported on MDA collection of \$86 for meeting meal and announced Casino Night on July 3rd to raise funds for MDA. Sister Zorn also reported on legislative issues, specifically on HR 2382.

Rob Burskey reported on Food Drive collection, approximately 350,000 lbs collected this year and thanked all coordinators and volunteers. Round of applause for Brother Burskey and a job well done.

Discussion followed on Glendale route adjustments. Huy Du and Alan Peranil, both from Glendale, and Yoon Chung from South Pasadena were introduced and welcomed by the membership.
